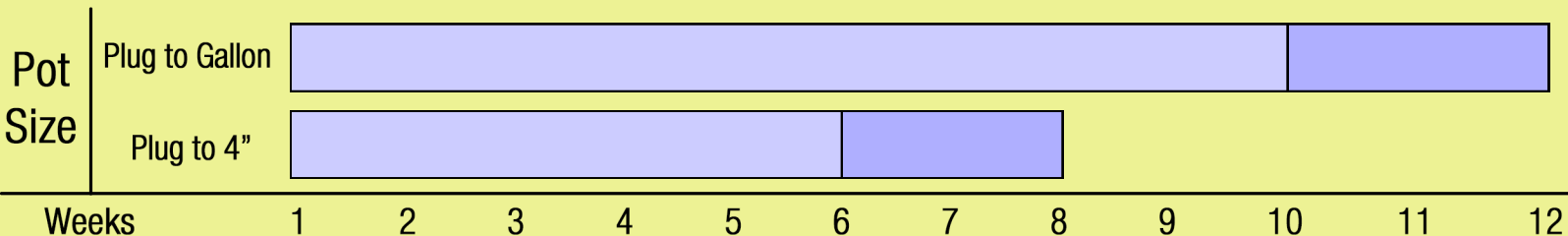


Growing Recipe

AGASTACHE 'BLUE BOA'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

pH: 5.5 - 6.5

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 1.5 - 2.0

Light Levels: Full sun

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 5 - 10

Possible Problems: Insect: Spider mites and white fly are possible

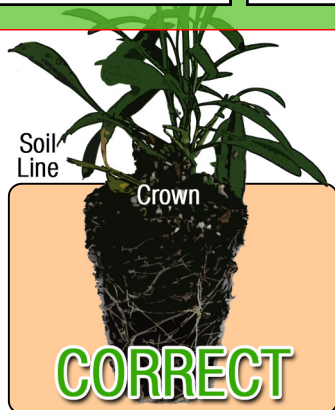
Habit: Upright, clumping

Diseases: Downy mildew possible in cool, wet conditions

Day Length for Flowering: Long day

Unlike any other Agastache, this beauty produces luxurious, deep violet-blue flower spikes held over ultra-green foliage. The flower spikes are long, wide and extremely showy. It's a great perennial color spot for summer bloom. It's drought tolerant once established and attracts hummingbirds as well as butterflies and bees. Won the "Too Good to Wait Performer" award at the 2013 Colorado State Perennial Trials.
